Sod Variety Information:

Bolero 100% Bolero Dwarf Tall Fescue. Fine, bluegrass-like texture; drought & heat tolerant; excellent disease resistance; insect resistant; beautiful dark, blue-green winter color; slower growing; fewer clippings.

Bolero Plus 90% Bolero Dwarf Tall Fescue/10% Kentucky Bluegrass; provides the same qualities offered in Bolero; the bluegrass assures better density, faster wear recovery, and better wintering.

90/10 90% Tall Fescue Blend/10% Kentucky Bluegrass; stands up better to high traffic areas; better drought and heat tolerance; disease and insect resistant; adapts to shade; coarser blade, deep-rooted, good color, low maintenance.

Blue/Rye 50% Kentucky Bluegrass Blend/50% Perennial Ryegrass Blend; fine-bladed look; dark blue-green color year-round; resistant to powdery mildew; Fusarium and rust; fair heat and drought tolerance.

Shade Blend 60% Dwarf Tall Fescue/15% Creeping Red Fescue/15% Chewings Fescue/10% Kentucky Bluegrass; designed to excel in full and filtered sun; contains two tall fescues and fine fescue varieties known to excel in up to 40% shade; excellent heat and wear tolerance for high traffic areas.



Other Sod Information:

- Residential orders (over 200 sq. ft.) must be pre-paid and placed 72 hours in advance.
- There is a \$95.00 delivery charge for deliveries up to 1,000 sq. ft.
- Deliveries over 1,000 sq. ft. are FREE! If a bobtail is needed in a tight location, a \$99.00 fee will be applied.
- No Sunday or holiday deliveries.
- Deliveries are between 7 AM and 4 PM; we cannot schedule a specific time.
- You will be notified by phone the day before with a 2-hour delivery window.
- Sod is ALIVE! Yamagami's recommends laying it the day it arrives, within 6 hours. (Updated 10/12/23 DS)

Delta Native Sod

Delta Sod has developed native grass varieties and combinations to make attractive, water-wise lawns. These grasses use up to 50% less water and need much less maintenance than conventional lawns.

NATIVE SOD Installation by Delta Sod

Native Sod Variety Information:

Native Mow-Free: Blend of 3 fine fescues: Idaho Fescue, Molate Fescue, and Western Mokelumne Fescue. Excellent shade & drought tolerance (designed for areas with 50% daily shade). Provides erosion control on sloped areas. Low maintenance – either mow or leave unmowed for a meadow-like appearance.

Native Bentgrass: Medium leaf texture. Thrives in full sun & partial shade. Withstands low mowing heights. Extremely drought tolerant. Uniform growth habit with excellent wear recovery due to self-repairing rhizomes.

Native Preservation: A blend of June grass, Purple Needlegrass, Nodding Needlegrass, and Molate Fescue. Narrow, fine-leaved texture. Withstands full sun and will tolerate partial shade. Excellent for sloped hillsides, riparian & restoration applications.

Kurapia: Lippia nodiflora L. “Kurapia”. Perennial plant, sterile, non-invasive. Produces small white flowers from May to November. Low growing 1-3” tall. Full Sun to Partial Sun. Once established, 60% less water than traditional sod.
